Michigan for Ukraine is a local fundraising program established in northern Michigan to directly support the humanitarian effort resulting from the invasion in Ukraine by Russia. All charitable contributions are used to allocate resources on a needs only basis as indicated by our partner **Olkusz Pomaga Ukrainie** located in Poland. Needed item lists will be provided to us by those on the ground, in which **Michigan for Ukraine** will procure the items, and work with our partners to have the resources distributed to the proper personnel in the field. This is a ground level approach allowing citizens and businesses in Michigan to provide immediate tangible assistance directly to those in need.

100% of your contributions will be distributed to one of the following three categories.

1. Support domestic refugees in Ukraine

microwaves, electric kettles, electric cookers, generators, food, medicine, hygiene products, etc.

2. Support kids community centers in Poland

School supplies, backpacks, books, clothing, toys, games, sending pen-pal letters, etc.

3. Support Communal Services in Ukraine

First aid kits, T-shirts, tactical shoes, hygiene products, batteries, etc.

If you would like to participate in helping connect your child with a child from Ukraine who's life has been affected by the war, we are sponsoring a program right here in Northern Michigan to send letters/pictures to these children, through our partner OLKUSZ POMAGA UKRAINIE. This program provides a great opportunity for parents to have a meaningful discussion about this conflict and empower your child to be directly involved with helping and supporting children of a similar age who are experiencing extraordinary circumstances

Teach kids the importance of freedom and democracy.

Help kids understand the magnitude of conflict.

Empower kids to get involved and be part of a solution.

Help your child establish a supportive friendship with someone in need.

Here's how to participate...

Have your child write a letter directed to a child of a similar age in Ukraine. Feel free to add pictures and paintings.

Encourage your child's letter to embrace empathy and compassion in their writings while being thoughtful to the extreme duress the people in Ukraine are currently experiencing.

Provide a safe way for the child in Ukraine to reach back out to your family in the form of an email address, mailing address, or PO Box.

*Insert the letter in an unsealed envelope, color a picture of the USA Flag on the outside of the envelope, and add the age of your child in **LARGE BOLD PRINT**. Please include a Google translated copy of the letter in the Ukrainian language if possible.*
